

Deluxe Master DMX Wall Station – SMD-8

The SMD-8 is a premium, wall-mountable Master DMX Control Station with eight programmable scenes and built-in fade times. Each unit connects to up to five Satellite Stations and includes two built-in Cat5 outputs for running control points in separate directions from the Master Station.

It can operate independently once programmed or alongside a lighting console/computer. A built-in control switch lets you choose whether the SMD-8 or your console/computer is the active DMX controller.

*SMD-8 Stations are static DMX scene recorders and cannot be used to capture sequences.

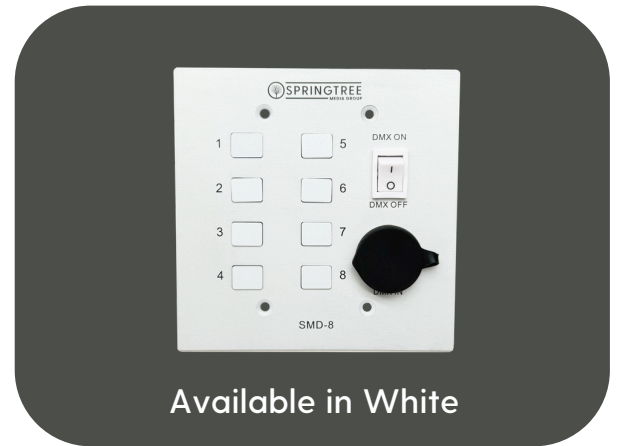

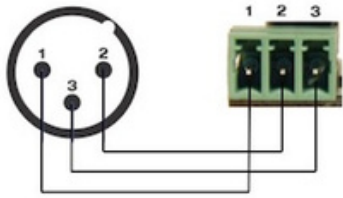
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DMX Input

A front-facing 3-pin DMX input makes it easy to connect a lighting console or computer for programming and control.

Pin 1 = Ground

Pin 2 = Negative

Pin 3 = Positive (Hot)

The SMD-8 sends DMX to your lights through an easy-to-wire Phoenix connector on the back of the unit.

Satellite Stations

Satellite Stations add control points around your facility. Up to 5 Satellite Stations can be used per SMD-8.

The SMD-8 includes two Satellite outputs, making it easy to run Cat5 cable in two directions without an SS-Hub. Each Satellite Station also includes a rear output for connecting additional stations in series. The SMD-8 is compatible with any Springtree Satellite Station.
